

# What you need to know about your Tallinn Card!

The Tallinn Card gives you free admission to museums and sights and unlimited access to Tallinn's public transport. In addition, you can receive discounted offers for tours, entertainment venues, cafés, restaurants and shops.

1 The plastic Tallinn Card is valid for 24, 48 or 72 hours from the first time you use it and only when supplied with date and type of the card in the space provided.

2 The mobile Tallinn Card is valid for 24, 48 or 72 hours from the first time you use it and only in the period indicated on the ticket.

3 Always check opening hours and dates on [tallinncard.ee](http://tallinncard.ee). Note that most museums are closed on **Mon, Tue** and on **public holidays** (Jan 1, Feb 24, Apr 7, Apr 9, May 1, May 28, June 23–24, Aug 20, Dec 24–26).

4 The Tallinn Card is **valid for only one admission** to each attraction listed in this booklet.

5 The Tallinn Card is **non-refundable** if lost, stolen or unused and cannot be exchanged for other types of cards.

6 With an adult card you can bring along two children under the age of 7 to museums and sights for free.
